



3-Piece Wall Surround

PRE-INSTALLATION PREP

1 CHECK PARTS INVENTORY

If any parts are damaged, immediately file a claim with the carrier. Minor damage (scuffs and scrapes) can be touched up later.

- Tub (unless it is a wall surround)
- Side wall panels (1 or 2, depending on model)
- Back wall panel
- 1 tube silicone caulk
- 1 black rubber suction cup
- Optional: Flange trim kit for walls

2 GATHER SUPPLIES

- Drywall screws (1½")
- Shim wedges
- Four pieces 2x4 lumber, 8 ft. long (for walls; see page 2)

Before you begin installation, please carefully read all instructions regarding the proper installation of your tub/shower unit.

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PREPARING SHOWER POCKET


INSTALLING TUB



Top of nailing flange, plus 1".

Mark and cut out drywall to fit back and side walls of shower. Remove drywall 1" beyond side wall and top nailing flanges. (Figures 1 and 2)

2 Install studs to provide support for flange and drywall

attachment. (Figure 3)





- CAUTION: IF NOT INSTALLED PROPERLY, THE TUB OR SHOWER UNIT MAY NOT PERFORM AS DESIGNED AND WILL NOT BE COVERED BY THE WARRANTY.
- Check tub/shower pocket area for level and for correct dimensions. Make sure drain hole in floor is in the correct position.
- 2 Have a plumber rough in the plumbing to drain/overflow, valve and outlet.
- 3 Place tub in pocket. Make sure tub drains properly by pouring water in it or checking the tub with a level. If in doubt, remove tub and review the previous steps. (Figure 4)




- 4 Screw tub flanges to wall framing.
- **5** Proceed to wall installation (see page 3).


INSTALLING SHOWER WALLS





3 Drill plumbing holes in side wall panel; then proceed to Step 4.

Proceed with steps 4A and 4B to install the side walls using the SnapJoint clip hardware (shown below).




Installing valve wall:

If parts of the shower valve and/or pipe nipple stick out:


- (1) Completely insert side wall at an angle to clear them;
- (2) Rotate the wall into place;

Push wall until front is flush with tub.



Installing non-valve wall:

Rest side wall on tub ledge, then push it into the wall channel until front is flush with tub.
